What are Medicaid Billing Services?

- *Technology integrates with current Medicaid systems to assist HCS with producing and managing school based medicaid billing*
- *Extract data from note sources including Excent and WRAP Services*
- *Provide means to approve work for billing*
- *Produce electronic billing files to send to the state to process our Medicaid billing*
- *Consume electronic remittance files which provides information to HCS on what was paid by Medicaid*
- *Provide reports of billing and remittance information to streamline the billing process*

Technology provides services to the Medicaid Billing arm of HCS in the form of electronic file integration and data reporting.



These services include program utilities which allow users to extract relevant billing material from our electronic data sources and construct standard billing files to be used to collect money from the state.

In addition, we also provide utilities to process return statement from Medicaid to track payments for services rendered. This is used to determine the distribution of Medicaid income to the various sources within HCS as well as provide all the reports HCS needs to manage its billing services.

By providing these services, technology makes electronic billing a reality for HCS improving efficiency, lowering costs, and overall, increasing returns from Medicaid. Far from a complete project, there is still a lot of room to grow as HCS could begin to consume even more electronic data from other sources and continue to improve efficiency with billing.
